## ROOS WIND FARM COMMUNITY BENEFIT FUND - Grants Awarded in 2014

In its first year, the Roos Wind Farm Community Benefit Fund made grants totalling £36,000. The following organisations benefitted.

Roos Memorial Institute received £5,000 towards a replacement floor.

Halsham Church Hall was awarded £12,000 to enable essential repairs to be undertaken in 2014. The refurbishment programme will ensure that the hall continues to be fit for purpose as a community venue.

All Saint's Church, Roos secured £8,500 to lay modern water and electrical supplies to the building as part of a wider modernisation programme in 2014.

**Roos Playing Fields Association** has been able to refurbish the pavilion window with a grant of £2,855 from the Roos Wind Farm Fund.

**Burton Pidsea Memorial Hall** is undergoing a major refurbishment programme and received a grant of £12,000 from the Roos Fund in 2014.

**Roos Juniors Football Club** has new training equipment thanks for a grant of £645 from the Roos Wind Farm Fund. Their players range in age from 4-11 years.
